The Basques are widely known for sheep milk production, but heirloom breeds of goats also inhabit the Pyrenees. Ahuntz Ederra, meaning ‘Beautiful Goat’ in the Basque language, is inspired by a cheese made for local markets and symbolizes the rugged beauty of these animals, the quality of their milk, and the richness of their environment.
